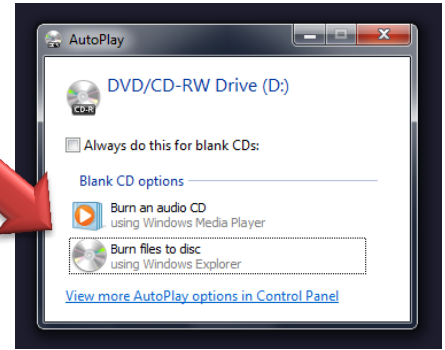



To Burn a Data CD for Sonorous with Windows 7

- Insert a writable CD into your CD burner drive
- When the “**AutoPlay**” dialog box pops up, click “**Burn files to disc using Windows Explorer**”



Note: if the “**AutoPlay**” dialog box does not pop up, click the “Start”  button from your toolbar, click “**Computer**,” then double-click your CD burner drive



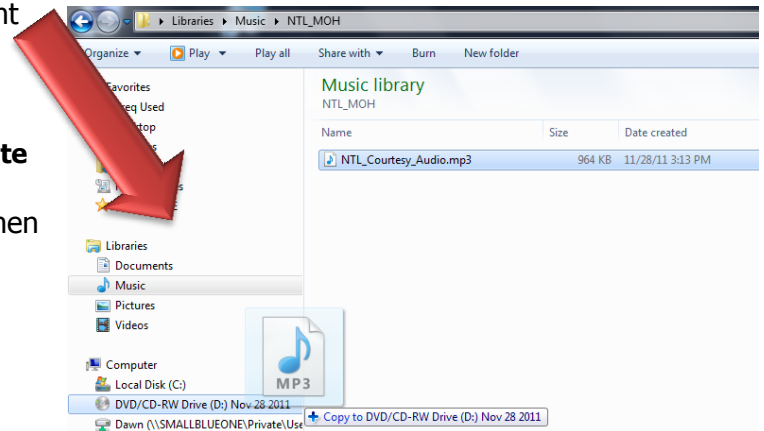
- In the “**Burn a Disc**” dialog box that pops up, type a name for the CD in the “**Disc title**” box (optional), click “**Like a USB flash drive**” then click “**Next**”

It might take several minutes for the disc to be formatted. When the format is complete, an empty disc folder opens

- Open the folder that contains the MP3 file(s) you want to burn & drag the files into the empty disc folder

Note: MP3 file must be Mono, with a recommended **128k Bit Rate (kbps), 44 KHz (44100 Hz) Sample Rate**

- To select multiple files, press & hold the “Ctrl” key, then click on the files you want to burn
- As you drag files into the folder, they are copied automatically to the CD
- After copying the file(s), you might need to close the disc session



Note: Instead of “dragging & dropping” files, after formatting the CD, you can select the files you want to burn in Windows Explorer, right-click the selected file(s), point to “**Send to**,” then click your disc burner drive
